Have you taken a positive action to improve your community, home, or school? We are looking for the 2017 Milwee Middle School Dreamer and Doer! Students will self-nominate with a teacher sponsor by February 23, 2017. One student will be chosen as Milwee Middle School's Dreamer and Doer!

****Students should respond to the following: What is a positive action you have taken to improve your community, home, or school? What inspired you to take this action?**

Please follow the steps below to complete your school nomination:

1. Students self-nominate for positive actions they have taken to inspire others. Your nomination should be 300 words or less (**essays over the limit will not be considered**) and can be submitted on paper or emailed to Ms. Wolfrum in the guidance department (debra_wolfrum@scps.k12.fl.us). You should focus on the positive action(s) you've taken to improve your community, home, or school.

Examples Include:

- Efforts in Strengthening Families: Staying active, eating healthy, exploring family history.
 - Conservation/Environmental Projects: Restoring community space, beach or community clean-up effort, protecting species & habitat.
 - Supporting Others: Donating items of need, helping with siblings or family chores, mentoring.
 - Safety Focus: Preparing for a disaster, modeling safe behaviors.
 - School Achievement: Improvement in spite of barriers, active participation.
 - Improving Your School: Restoring a play area, helping a teacher, encouraging kindness among fellow classmates.
 - Leading by Example: Inspiring siblings/friends, bullying prevention, addressing a community issue.
 - Any other positive action
2. Your nomination must also include a teacher to endorse your application. The teacher will write or email 75 words or less why they support your nomination. This must also be submitted to Ms. Wolfrum by **February 23, 2017**. **Applications without a teacher indorsement will not be considered in the selection process. The name of the teacher endorsing your nomination should be at the top of your essay. A teacher's name should not be on the essay unless he/she has agreed to sponsor the nomination.**

***Self-nominations without a teacher endorsement will not be considered in the selection process.**

***Essays over the limit will not be considered for this recognition.**
