- John Adams- lawyer (future Founding Father and President)
- Abigail Adams- John's wife, well-educated
- Samuel Adams- John's cousin, a leader of the Sons of Liberty, wealthy
- Captain Preston- British commander of the soldiers involved in the shooting
- John Hancock- Merchant, politician, patriot
- Sons of Liberty- colonial group formed to protest British Acts
- Patriot- nickname for a colonist who were unhappy with British policies, later want American independence
- Tory- nickname for a colonist who remained loyal to Britain (Loyalist)
- Redcoats- nickname for British soldiers (lobsterbacks)
